

# Stronger Starts, Brighter Futures

## Supporting Newborn Safety and Early Learning

The Hospital Foundation of Decatur County plays a vital role in supporting the health and well-being of local families by investing in programs that make a lasting difference for children from the very beginning of life. Through the Dr. Mary McCullough Fund, the Foundation proudly funds Sleep Sacks for the Women's Center, ensuring newborns and their families receive a safe sleep resource from day one.



Sleep sacks promote safer sleep practices by reducing the risk of sleep-related incidents while also helping infants rest more comfortably. Beyond immediate safety, these sleep sacks offer parents guidance and peace of mind, helping establish healthy sleep habits that support a child's development long after they leave the hospital.

In addition to supporting physical health, the Foundation nurtures early learning and imagination through its Imagination Library program, in partnership with the Decatur County United Fund. By providing children with free, age-appropriate books, the program helps strengthen early literacy skills and encourages meaningful bonding between children and caregivers.



Together, initiatives like the Sleep Sacks and the Imagination Library support the whole child, promoting safety, learning, and emotional growth. When children are given strong, healthy starts, the benefits ripple outward, creating stronger families and a healthier Decatur County community for years to come.
