Matt Weber Story

A Life-Changing Partnership:

How the Hospital Foundation Supports Transformative Healthcare

The impact of compassionate care and education was clear when Lonnie Lacey, initially skeptical of healthcare, transformed his life after an introduction to Matt Weber, PharmD.

As part of DCMH's Diabetes Education & Management initiatives, Matt works closely with patients to monitor A1C levels and provide tailored guidance. When Matt first met Lonnie in June 2023, his A1C was dangerously high at over 9%, increasing his risk for serious complications like blindness, heart attack, and kidney failure.

Through regular one-on-one meetings, affordable medication management, and lifestyle coaching, Lonnie achieved remarkable progress. By September 2023, his A1C dropped to an impressive 5.8%, dramatically reducing his health risks. He lost 30 pounds and adopted a sustainable diet, all while continuing to enjoy the foods he loved.



Lonnie credits Matt's proactive support—including remote monitoring via continuous glucose sensors—with helping him succeed. “Matt made it so simple. We found solutions together that worked for me,” Lonnie shared.

This success story highlights the importance of programs like the Diabetes Education & Management initiatives that the Hospital Foundation champions. By funding critical resources and education, the Foundation enables transformative care that changes lives—just like Lonnie's.
